TRANSITION YEAR

Transition year offers a range of co-curricular activities designed to aid in developing maturity and self-confidence, also awareness of others.

These include: community service, language exchanges and homestays, participation in the school musical, drama and Gaisce, the President's award. Work experience is an integral part of the TY programme, as is a residential outdoor adventure sports course. Our girls have taken part in university science weeks, and can take time out of school to specialise in sports. In addition, students are encouraged to take part in competitions such as Young Scientists, Young Social Innovators, AIB Build-A-Bank, Young Entrepreneurs, Public-Speaking, etc.
