Washtenaw Christian Academy is a Christian, coeducational day school located in Saline, Michigan. WCA is dedicated to providing a quality education. It is accredited through the Association of Christian School International. One of the goals of WCA is to seek to influence the intellectual and spiritual formation of all its students. WCA enrolls approximately 120 students each year, with 5 students from countries outside of the USA.

Location

Washtenaw Christian Academy is located in Saline, Michigan with a population of about 8,000. The city is popular for its annual Celtic Festival, which attracts people from all over the United States. Saline is just 30 miles from Ann Arbor, Michigan, which has a major scene for college sports, notably at the University of Michigan, a member of the Big Ten Conference. Several wellknown college sports facilities exist in the city, including Michigan Stadium, the second largest American football stadium in the world with a 106,201 seating capacity. The weather in Saline, Michigan, is highly variable and is greatly influenced by the Great Lakes. Saline experiences a four-season climate. Average high temperatures in the summer range between 70°F and 85°F, with average high temperatures in the winter ranging from 20°F to 35°F.

Washtenaw Christian Academy is dedicated to educating the whole person. WCA seeks to enable each student to succeed in his/ her appropriate curriculum. Moreover, the student will be prepared, through a rigorous and comprehensive academic program.
